M Sometimes glossy travel brochures and websites tell you that a destination is truly remote. Sometimes you question their definition of 'remote'.

However, to say that the Torres del Paine National Park in Chile is off the beaten track doesn't even come close. With this destination you realise that 'patience is a virtue', but the reward is truly magnificent. After a 4-hour plane flight from Santiago and a 5 hour trip by van you are confronted with perhaps the very best views of glaciers and waterfalls in the world. It was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1978.

Unusually for such a secluded destination, Torres del Paine offers year-round adventure due to its low rainfall and low altitude.
