HIGH TIME Chile's Atacama Desert, the driest in the world, is ringed with volcanic peaks. Now **explora en Atacama** offers guests a chance to summit one of the region's most iconic, the 19,409-foot, snowcapped Licancabur. Adventurers spend the first five of seven days acclimating while hiking volcanoes in the 17,000-foot range,

with comfortable overnights in the 50-room Hotel de Larache, where soothing amenities include four outdoor pools. The last two days are spent **navigating Inca ruins** along Licancabur's final 4,430 feet en route to the crater's lake. *Departures twice monthly; \$4,768 per person, including all meals and activities.*
