## OUR LODGES IN PATAGONIA

On this journey between Patagonia National Park and Torres del Paine we will accompany you from the beginning to end with an all-inclusive program through our lodges and their guides: accommodation in Explora lodges, transfers in exclusive Explora planes and vehicles, meals, bar, a selection of wines, guided explorations, and all entrance fees to national parks.

### PATAGONIA NATIONAL PARK, CHILE

4 nightss / 5 days

The lodge, located in the Patagonia National Park, was built by the Tompkins Foundation and is in the Chacabuco Valley sector. It has 10 rooms (2 suites and 8 standard) with views of Cerro Tamango and Tamanguito and the park in general. Its sustainable architecture was designed to reduce interference with the natural surroundings and in that way be able to enjoy the over 300.000 hectares of parkland.



### TORRES DEL PAINE, CHILE

4 nights / 5 days

The lodge is in the heart of the national park and has 49 rooms (6 suites and 43 standard) designed to make the most of the silence and privacy, guaranteeing a deep rest after a day of exploration. It also has stunning views of Lake Pehoé and the Paine Massif.



### EL CHALTÉN, ARGENTINA

4 nights / 5 days

The lodge, located near the Southern Ice Fields, has 20 rooms (3 suites and 17 standard) with amazing views of Valle Eléctrico, the Marconi Glacier and the mountains in the Los Huemules Conservation Reserve.

## OUR TRANSFERS: BY AIR AND BY LAND

You need to travel with experts for a journey across a vast territory like Patagonia. This is why we have forged an alliance with another expert in the region, DAP Airways, to take our travelers from the Patagonia National Park in the Aysén Region to Torres del Paine in the Magallanes Region. The transfer from Torres del Paine to Explora in El Chaltén, Argentina, will be in our vehicles.

DAP has over 20 years of experience flying in Patagonia and is responsible for 80% of the flights between the continent and Antarctica.

There are flights every 7 days between the Patagonia National Park and Torres Del Paine.

- The planes used are BEECHCRAFT 250 – 300 / or similar.
- Capacity for 6 passengers and 2 crew members.
- Baggage: maximum of 20 kilos of baggage per person.
- Transportation by Explora vehicle to and from Cochrane and Puerto Natales airports at pre-established times.

The transfer by Explora vehicle between Torres del Paine and El Chaltén is carried out according to the pre-established schedule between October and March, passing through the Cancha Carrera / Cerro Castillo border crossing.

HOW WE EXPLORE

You will be able to explore and understand a part of Patagonia in each destination, perfect compliments to live and experience the territory that we face in its totality.

In Torres del Paine there is the constant presence of the Paine massifs, granite giants modeled by the force of the glacial ice. Meanwhile, you experience mountain culture in El Chaltén, which invites you to explore the many valleys and glaciers that extend from the Southern Ice Fields. On the other hand, the Patagonia National Park, part of the Carretera Austral circuit, offers us great geographical contrasts and active wildlife thanks to years of conservation by the Tompkins Foundation.



We have over 30 explorations in Patagonia National Park, which range from the basic level to advanced and cover both the national park and its surroundings in hikes, bike/e-bike rides, kayak and overland tours. You will be able to observe Lake Cochrane and diverse fauna like pumas, huemuls, ñandus and guanacos.

You will also be able to visit and get to know the Conservation Center and Douglas Tompkins's conservation legacy.



We have over 45 explorations with different levels of difficulty at Torres del Paine. Our different explorations, such as horseback rides, hikes, mountain climbing and overland crossings allow you to observe beautiful turquoise lakes, glaciers, lenga and ñirre forests, mountains, viewpoints, prairies, and rivers, in addition to the most emblematic sections of the trekking known as the "W". Gaucho culture is present in different activities and explorations.



In El Chaltén we have over 30 explorations with different levels of difficulty that tour parks and reserves through hiking, rock climbing, mountain climbing and overland crossings.

You will be able to observe the valleys and glaciers that extend from the Southern Ice Fields, the Los Glaciares National Park, the Los Huemules Conservation Reserve, Lago del Desierto and the Marconi Glacier.
